

**Hi Everyone,**

**Included below are every California League team's post-season All-Stars. My sources were the third edition of the Encyclopedia of Minor League Baseball, the Baseball America Almanac from 1983 through 2010 and the Sporting News Baseball Guides from 1941 through 2006.**

**I thought I had completed this last week when I went to check the spelling of a player's name and discovered different All-Star teams in the mid 1980's. This led me to go back and check each publication for discrepancies and I found quite a few. Listed next to each franchise is the number of All-Stars, not the number of awards.**

**All members of every All-Star team found are listed. Discrepancies are listed at the end. For clarification purposes, the Encyclopedia of Minor League Baseball lists All-Star teams from 1941 through 2005, the Sporting News from 1941 through 2006 and Baseball America Almanac from 1983 through 2009. In 1986 I found that the Encyclopedia of Minor League Baseball and the Sporting News Baseball Guide both published the California League All-Star team with a Northern Division AND Southern Division All-Star at each position. Baseball America published one overall California League All-Star team for both divisions with the notation of "...by Baseball America..." What followed were phone calls to both Miles Wolff and Lloyd Johnson, editors of the Encyclopedia of Minor League Baseball and at the time, owners of Baseball America. Time tends to blur memories and neither could really explain the differences in the All-Star teams.**

**The ten current California League teams are listed first, followed by the defunct franchises. The number of All-Stars is listed by each team's name, and the number is reduced by each multiple winner.**
