Key:

Prelim. Round: Introduced in 1995, the Preliminary Round matches the #2 and #3 (Mini-Series) seeds in a first, or preliminary round of playoffs before the Northern and Southern Division Championship (Semi-finals) round. Also referred to as the Mini-Series.

Semi-Finals: In the days of the President's Cup, was a true semi-final round, since 1979 this round has served as the Northern and Southern Division Championship round (or Freeway and Valley Division Championships).

Champ Round: The final round of the California League playoffs that determine the league champion in 1955 and from 1957 to the present and the final round of the President's Cup from 1941 through 1954 and 1956.

One Game: The rare one game playoff that decides a playoff appearance and/or a first half championship. In some rare cases, this has ended up being a regularly scheduled game in the second half of the season.

Note: The Channel Cities Oilers, Las Vegas Wranglers, Merced Bears, Riverside Reds, San Bernardino Stars, Santa Clara Padres and the Ventura County Gulls never appeared in California League playoff games.

The Stockton Ports, the team with the most wins in the California League playoffs have been almost unbeatable in the semi-finals, having won 18 out of their 26 semi-final series, a .692 winning percentage. They have been a perfect 4-0, with a 12-5 record in the 2000's having defeated Modesto 3 games to 0 in 2002, Visalia 3 games to 2 in 2003 and San Jose 3 games to 2 in 2008 and 3 games to 1 in 2011.

The Lake Elsinore Storm have owned the preliminary round of the California League playoffs. In the twenty-one years the California League has had this first round of the playoffs, the Storm have appeared in thirteen of them, compiling 8 series wins for a winning percentage of .615! From 2002 thru 2008, a period of seven years, the Storm was in five of the Preliminary Rounds of the California League playoffs and won four of them, a winning percentage of .800, defeating Lancaster 2-0 in 2002, losing to Inland Empire in 2003, 2-0, and then defeating High Desert 2-1 in 2006, Inland Empire, 2-1 in 2007 and Inland Empire, again in 2008, 2-0. They were 8-4, a .667 winning percentage in that seven year period. In the twenty years of the Mini-Series, the Storm have won 17 games, a figure that no California League team has surpassed and their 8 Mini-Series wins is a mark that no other California League team has achieved.

...You Can Look It Up...

The Fresno Cardinals played in the very first California League's President's Cup playoffs in 1941 and lost to the Santa Barbara Saints 4 games to 1. It would be eleven years before Fresno played in a California League final again, and from then on they owned the championship round! The Fresno Cardinals/Giants won 8 of their final 9 championship finals, an .889 winning percentage! They defeated San Jose 4 games to 2 in 1952, 2 games to 1 in 1968 and 3 games to 2 in 1974. They beat the Stockton Ports 3 games to 1 in both 1955 and 1956 and 3 games to 2 in 1985. In 1958 they beat the Visalia Redlegs 3 games to 1 and in their final California League championship, the Fresno Giants edged the Reno Silver Sox 4 games to 3. The only blemish in their final nine championship appearances was administered by the 1971 Visalia Mets who swept the Giants in two games.

The Inland Empire 66ers (San Bernardino Spirit/San Bernardino Stampede) appeared in eight Division Championship rounds in a twelve year span, from 1995 through 2006. They won six of the eight series for an outstanding winning percentage of .750! They swept the Lake Elsinore Storm in three games in 1995, defeated Rancho Cucamonga 3 games to 2 in both 1997 and 1999. On their way to consecutive California League championships, they beat the Lancaster JetHawks 3 games to 2 in 2000. Lake Elsinore beat the Stampede in 2002 3 games to 2. Inland Empire returned to the winners circle in 2003 defeating the Quakes 3 games to 1. The Lancaster JetHawks beat them 3 games to 1 game in 2004. On the way to their fifth California League championship in twelve years, the 66ers beat Lake Elsinore 3 games to 1 in 2006.

The San Jose Giants played in the very first preliminary round in 1995 against the Stockton Ports and were the first team to ever win a California League preliminary round series. The Giants swept the Ports in two games with a dominating pitching staff. The Giants shut out the Ports in both games, limiting Stockton to 3 hits in 2 games! Troy Brohawn faced the minimum 27 batters in shutting out Stockton 2-0 in game one. In game two, Keith Foulke, Carl Schramm and Russ Ortiz combined to limit the Ports to 1 hit as the Giants cruised to a 12-0 victory. San Jose beat Visalia 2 games to 1 in the 1999 preliminary round. In 2004, San Jose came back to defeat Stockton by winning the final two games after losing the opener in Stockton. In 2015, San Jose defeated Stockton 2 games to 1. Until, 2012 San Jose was the only California League team to have never lost a preliminary round series, sporting a perfect 3-0 record! Their perfect record was snapped by the Modesto Nuts, who after losing the opener in San Jose, bounced back to take the next two with former Giants manager Lenn Sakata at the helm and put an end to San Jose's perfect series record in the Preliminary Round.

Twelve times a team has gone through the California League playoffs without losing a game. The "Perfect" Stockton Ports have done it four times! The Lodi Lions/Dodgers are the only other team to do it more than once.

Composite California League Playoff Records: (Teams with Losing Records in the California League Playoffs)

Twenty-two teams with losing records have played in the California League playoffs and just two of them, the 2011 Lake Elsinore Storm and the 2013 Inland Empire 66ers have won the California League championship. Seventeen of the teams have played in the past twenty years since the expansion of the playoffs with the introduction of the Preliminary Round/Mini-Series. This increased the number of playoff teams from four to six.

The 2011 Lake Elsinore Storm and the 2013 Inland Empire 66ers have had the greatest impact of all the teams with a losing record, having both won the California League championship. The Storm beat Inland Empire 2 games to 1 in the Mini-Series, the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes 3 games to 1 in the Southern Division Finals and finally took 3 out of 4 from the Stockton Ports in the Championship Finals. The 66ers beat Rancho Cucamonga 2 games to 1 in the Mini-Series, the Lancaster JetHawks 3 games to 2 in the Southern Division Finals and then swept the San Jose Giants in the Championship Finals.

The 1997 San Bernardino Stampede made it to the California League Finals, by sweeping the Visalia Oaks, 2 games to 0, in the Freeway Division Mini-Series and then edging the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes 3 games to 2 in the Freeway Division Finals, before being swept by the Valley Division Champion High Desert Mavericks 3 games to 0.

The 1984 Bakersfield Dodgers also made it to the California League championship finals by defeating the Fresno Giants 2 games to 1 in the Southern Division finals. They were beaten by the Modesto A's 3 games to 1 in the California League championship round.

The 1959 Bakersfield Bears also made it to the California League finals by winning the first half of the season with a 42-29 record. By finishing fifth in the six team circuit in the second half with a 28-42 mark, the Bears fell a game below .500 for the year. The Modesto Reds beat them 4 games to 2 in the finals.

The 2009 Rancho Cucamonga Quakes have the distinction of competing in the California League playoffs with the worst record of all time, 61-79 (.436), eighteen games below .500. They did, however, win the South Mini-Series by sweeping the Lake Elsinore Storm, before losing in five games to the High Desert Mavericks.

Of the twenty-two teams with losing records to make the California League playoffs, fifteen of them have lost in the first round. Of the seven teams that did win a playoff series, one of them defeated another team with a losing record: The 1998 Lake Elsinore Storm defeating the Visalia Oaks and then lost in the next round. Thus, in reality, only six times out of twenty-one has a team with a losing record (a .286 winning percentage) won at least one playoff series against a team with a winning record in the California League playoffs.

California League's Best Record:

The best regular season record does not guarantee a California League championship. In the fifty-two years when playoffs were actually played and determined the league champion, only 23 times (44 percent) has the team with the best regular season record won the playoffs

From 1958 through 1967, a span of ten years, the team with the best regular season record was crowned California League Champion, either by winning the playoffs or by having won both halves, in which case no playoffs were held. Four of the years a team won both halves and no playoffs were held ('60 & '61 Reno, '64 Fresno, '66 Modesto). In '58 Fresno won, '59 Modesto, '62 and '67 San Jose and '63 and '65 saw the Stockton Ports win.
